USE YOUR OWN CUP OR MUG FOR COFFEE
PACK YOUR LUNCH IN REUSABLE CONTAINERS
SAY NO TO DISPOSABLE STRAWS, CUTLERY, AND TABLEWARE
SKIP THE PLASTIC PRODUCE BAGS AT THE STORE
RECYCLE, AND KNOW WHAT YOU CAN AND CAN'T RECYCLE IN YOUR COMMUNITY
JOIN A LOCAL CLEAN-UP EFFORT TO TAKE PLASTIC OUT OF THE ENVIRONMENT
