Be creative, have fun and capture the spirit of Dana Point's surf culture!



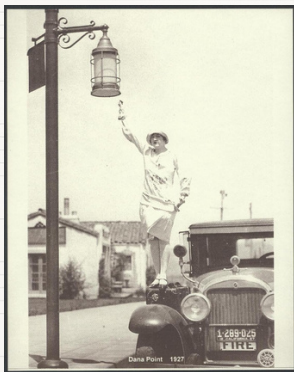

where Dana's legacy still lives today!

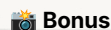


Bonus Activity Two Years Before the Mast Challenge

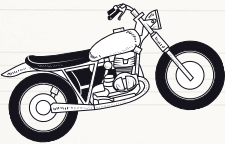
SCAVENGER HUNT CLUE STOP 7
